

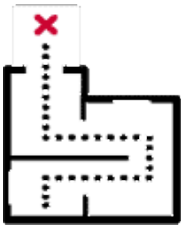
Here Are Some Achievements Made Possible by Donations to the American Red Cross Chapter in Santa Barbara County Between January 1 and July 31, 2005

Disaster Response



- Offered emergency help to **hundreds of local residents** forced to evacuate due to the floodings and mudslides in Maria Ignacio Creek, Sycamore Canyon, Old San Marcos Pass, La Conchita and other areas.
- Assisted **35 families** devastated by loss of housing, clothing, furnishings and other personal possessions.
- Opened **four Emergency Evacuation Shelters** for victims of the January floods and mudslides.

Emergency Preparedness



- Delivered Emergency Preparedness materials to more than **500 homes** in wildfire risk areas.
- Distributed disaster preparedness and health and safety materials to over **2,000 school children, seniors and community members** throughout Santa Barbara County.
- Trained **15 Red Cross volunteers** in how to set up an Emergency Evacuation Shelter and other aspects of Disaster Response.
- Delivered over **30 presentations** on emergency preparedness to seniors and community groups throughout the county.
- Participated in **two emergency multi-agency drills** to improve the county's readiness to respond to natural and man-made disasters.

Health & Safety Training



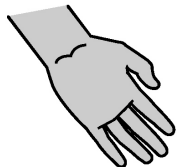
- Taught First Aid and CPR Lifesaving Skills to **6,422** Santa Barbara County residents.
- Trained **more than 1,230** people in Lifeguarding and Water Safety Skills.
- Instructed **136** young people in Babysitter's Training and Child Care Classes.

Armed Forces Emergency Services



- Delivered emergency communications, counseling and other crisis assistance that helped **over 50 military personnel** connect with their families.
- Held five presentations for over **60 military** families on Red Cross services available to active personnel.

Volunteer Support



- Depended upon assistance of more than **1,100 Red Cross volunteers** throughout the county.
